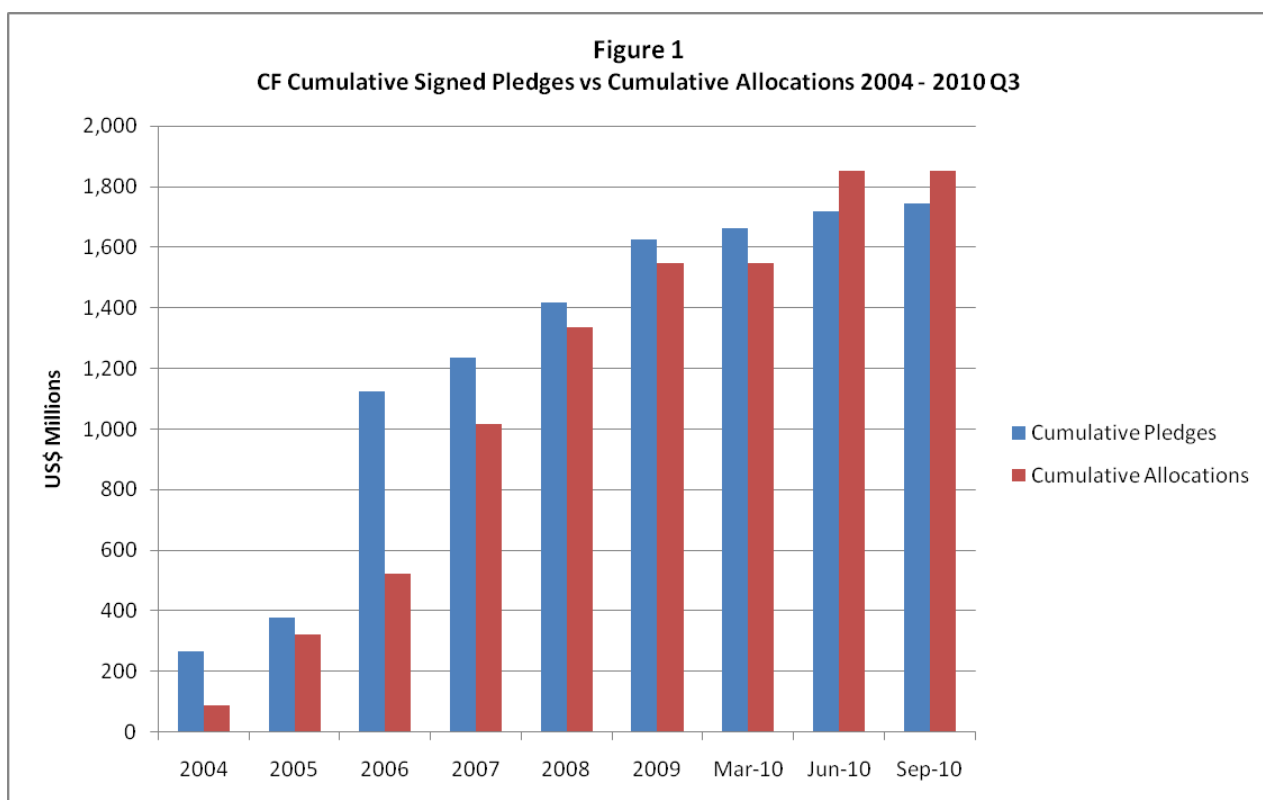

1. FUND POSITION

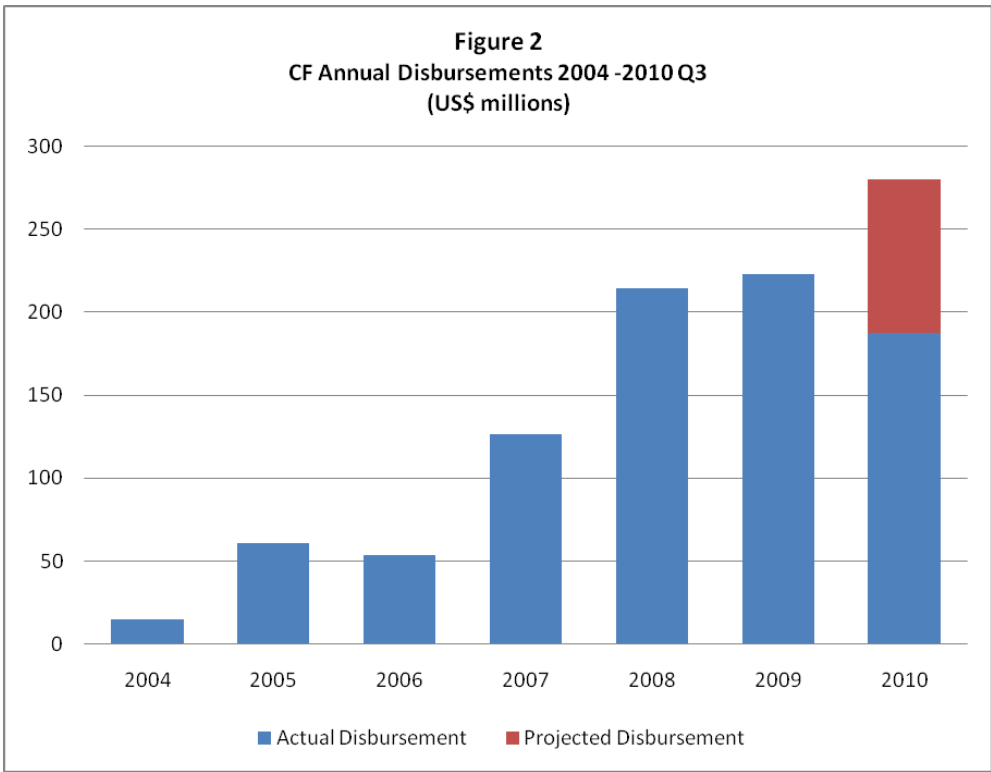
- **Summary of Cumulative Allocations:** As of September 30 2010, cumulative allocations from the Catalytic Fund (CF) totaled US\$1,853.6 million – US\$33.8 million more than the total available for allocation (US\$1,819.8 million equivalent) as represented by pledges in signed donor agreements plus investment income on the cash balance.
- **New Pledges Announced:** Irish Aid announced a new pledge totaling EUR 3.8 million, (US\$4.9 million equivalent). The agreement is expected to be signed by end-November and the contribution is expected to be received by end-December 2010.
- **Agreements Signed in the Quarter:** Between July 1, 2010 and September 30, 2010, donors signed agreements for US\$5.5m equivalent. New agreements were signed with Belgium (EUR 4 million; US\$5.44 million equivalent) and Romania (EUR 50,000; US\$ 60,000 equivalent). Pledges announced but still unsigned as of September 30, 2010 totaled US\$111.6¹ million equivalent. Table A shows pledges and receipts by Donor and by year since CF inception as well as the summary of unsigned pledges by donor.
- **Cumulative Pledge Total:** As of September, 30 2010, the value of all signed pledges totaled US\$1,745.1 million equivalent. This total includes the new signed pledges of US\$5.5 million equivalent and reflects an increase in value of the unpaid portion of signed pledges due to currency fluctuations -- a gain of approximately US\$20.5 million equivalent. NB: The cumulative pledge total includes approximately US\$180 million equivalent in unpaid pledges, nearly all of which is denominated in currencies other than US dollars. For the purposes of this report, exchange rates as of September 30 2010 were used to approximate the value of the unpaid pledges. Until all pledges are paid in, the cumulative pledge total will continue to change as exchange rates fluctuate. Figure 1 below shows trends in cumulative signed pledges and cumulate allocations for the CF from inception through September 30, 2010.

¹ This includes only pledges under agreements expected to be signed by December 31, 2010.

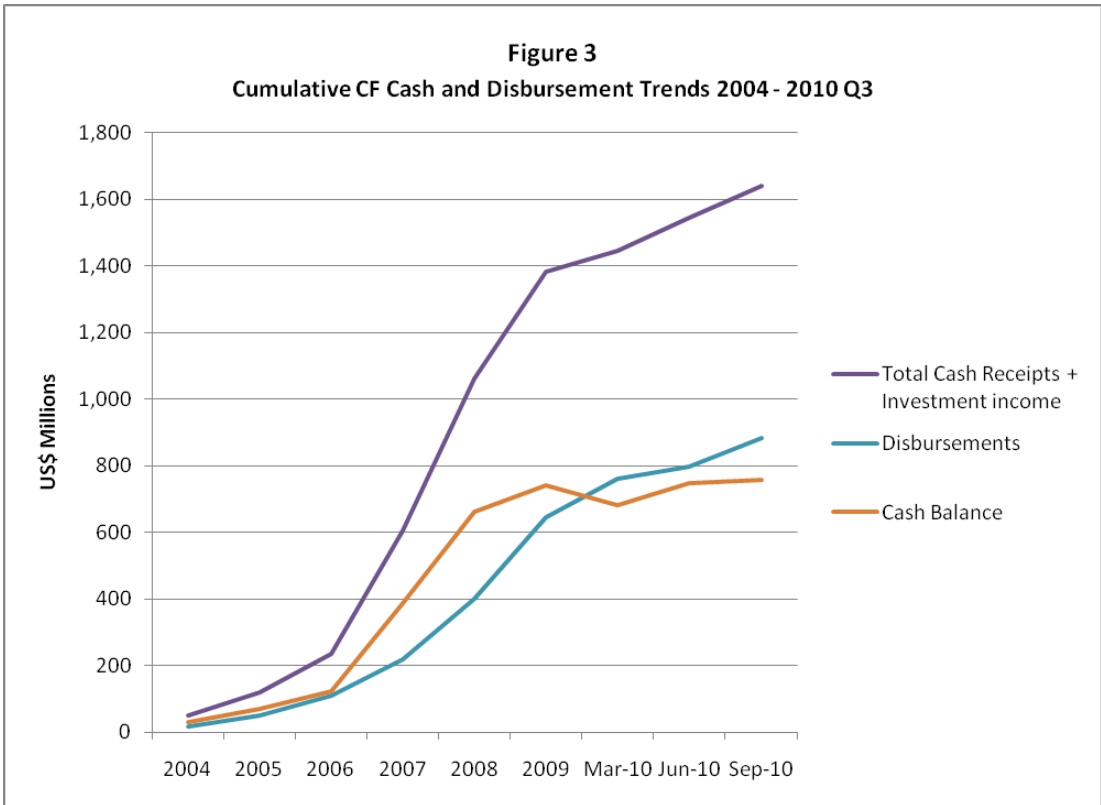


➤ **Cash position:**

- **Cash Receipts:** Cash receipts in the second quarter of CY2010 totaled US\$84.3 million from Australia and Spain. Cumulative cash receipts since inception total US\$1,565.1 million.
- **Investment Income:** Income earned on undisbursed cash balances totaled US\$10.7 million in Q3 CY2010 with investment income since inception totaling US\$74.7 million. All investment income earned on cash balances is added back into the CF for allocation by the CF Committee.
- **Disbursements:** CF grant disbursements in the quarter totaled US\$84.6 million for a cumulative CY2010 total of US\$186 million. US\$883 million has been disbursed since CF inception (including administration fees and disbursements of supervision allocations by Supervising Entities). Figure 2 shows the steady increase in annual CF disbursements since fund inception. Full year 2010 CF disbursements are projected by the FTI Secretariat to be in the range of US\$250 million to US\$350 million. Table B shows all CF allocations since fund inception and actual disbursement for each as of September 30, 2010.



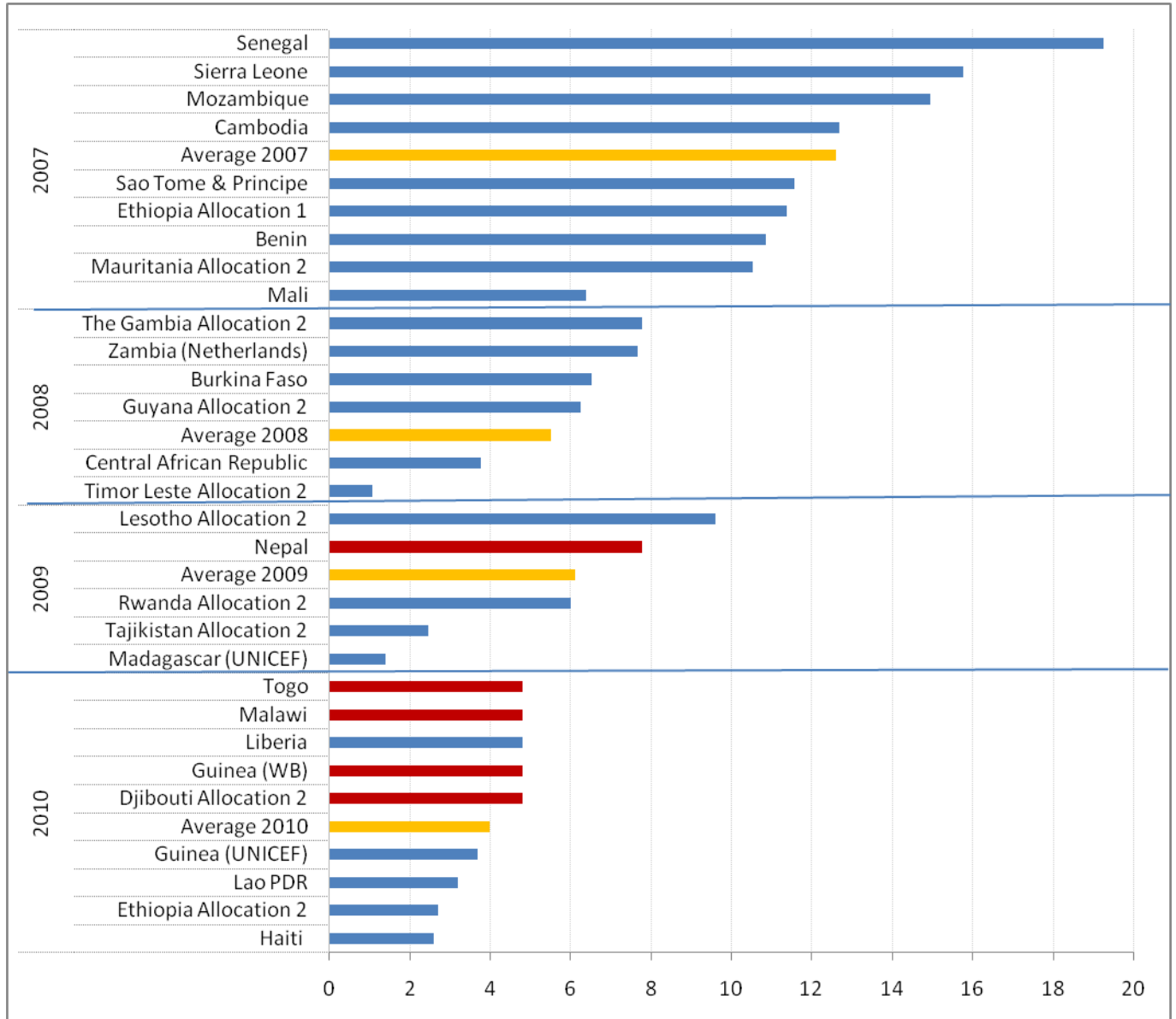
- **Cash Balance:** As of September 30, 2010, the cash balance of the CF was US\$756 million, up US\$11 million from 2010 Q2. Figure 3 below shows year-on-year trends for cumulative cash received (donor contribution receipts plus investment income), disbursements, and cash balance from CF inception



2. GRANT PROCESSING

- **Signing of Catalytic Fund Grant Agreements:** Five grant agreements were signed in the quarter – Ethiopia, Guinea (UNICEF portion), Lesotho, Liberia and Lao PDR. As of September 30, grant agreements remained unsigned for CF allocations to Nepal (which was approved in November 2009), and for Djibouti, Malawi, Togo and the World Bank portion of the allocation made to Guinea (all allocations made at the May 2010 CF Committee meeting). Figure 4 below highlights progress made since 2007 in reducing time between CF Committee allocation decision and signing of a grant or transfer agreement for the allocation. Grants unsigned at September 30, 2010 are shown in red.

3. PROJECTED CF FUNDING REQUESTS FOR NOVEMBER 2010

- **Countries Projected to Submit Funding Applications:** Information received through September 30 2010 from Local Education Groups indicated that three countries would submit applications to the CF Committee for allocation decision in November 2010. These are: Rwanda, Papua New Guinea and Mozambique. The Secretariat's estimate of aggregate requests is approximately US\$179 million.

4. PROJECTED ALLOCATION AUTHORITY FOR NOVEMBER 2010:

- The table summarizes the CF Committee allocation authority available going in to the November CF Committee meeting and the projected allocation authority if the three country requests are approved in full. Inflows include pledges signed in October 2010 and pledges expected to be signed by December 31, 2010.
