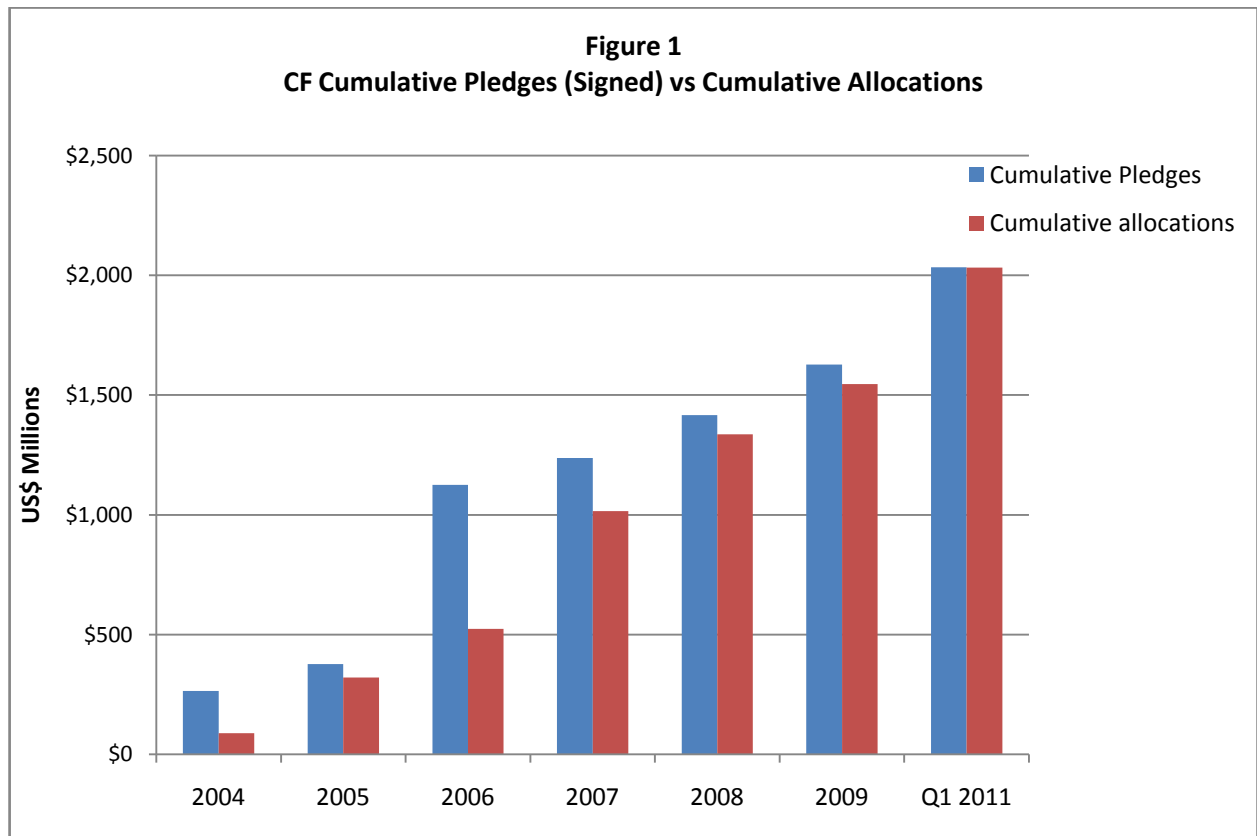

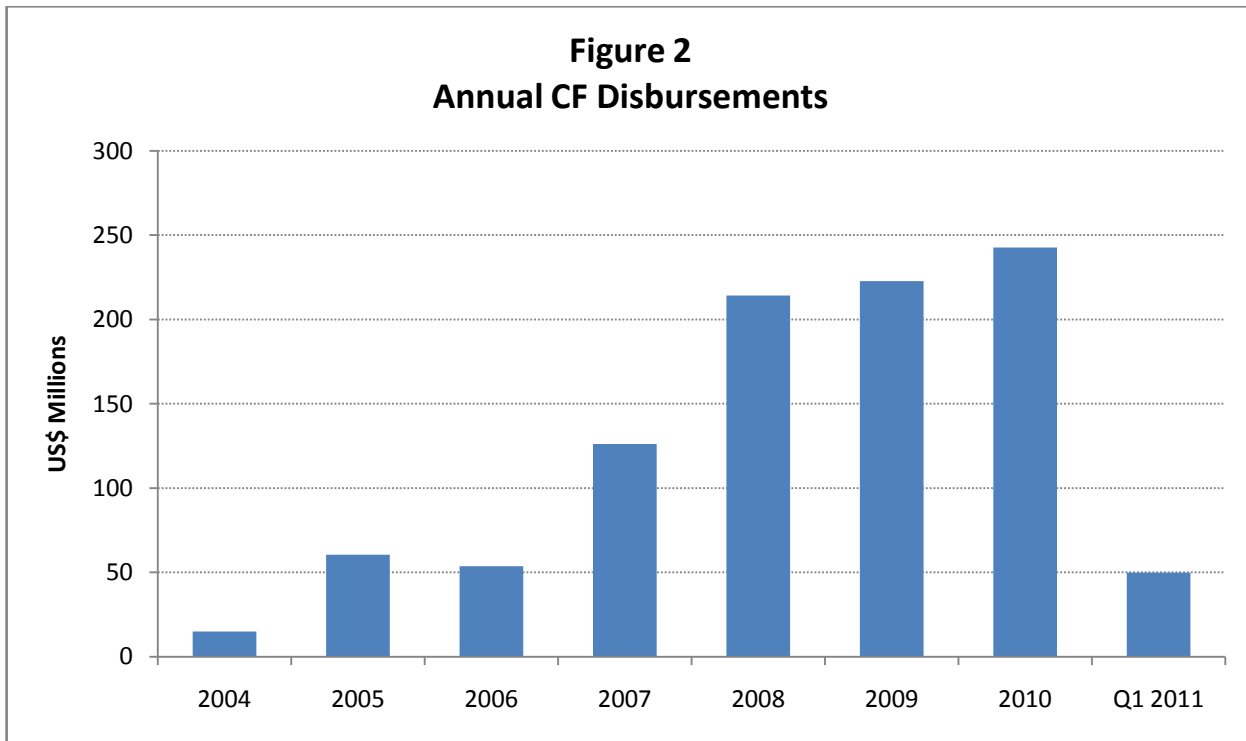
**1. FUND POSITION**

- **Summary of Cumulative Allocations:** As of March 31, 2011, cumulative allocations from the Catalytic Fund (CF) totaled US\$2,032.6 million –nearly equal to the value at that time of pledges in signed donor agreements US\$2,033.5 million.
- **Agreements Signed in the Quarter:** Between January 1, 2011 and March 31, 2011, donors signed agreements for US\$116.1 million equivalent. New agreements were signed with Denmark ,Germany and the UK. Table A shows pledges and receipts by Donor and by year since CF inception.
- **Cumulative Pledge Total:** As of March 31, 2011, the value of all signed pledges totaled US\$2,033.5 million equivalent. This total includes the new signed pledges of US\$116.1 million equivalent and reflects an increase in value of the unpaid portion of signed pledges due to currency fluctuations -- a gain of approximately US\$10.5 million equivalent. [NB: The cumulative pledge total includes approximately US\$248.8 million equivalent in unpaid pledges, nearly all of which is denominated in currencies other than US dollars. For the purposes of this report, exchange rates as of March 31, 2011 were used to approximate the value of the unpaid pledges. Until all pledges are paid in, the cumulative pledge total will continue to change as exchange rates fluctuate.] Figure 1 below shows trends in cumulative signed pledges and cumulative allocations for the CF from inception through March 31, 2011.



**Cash position:**

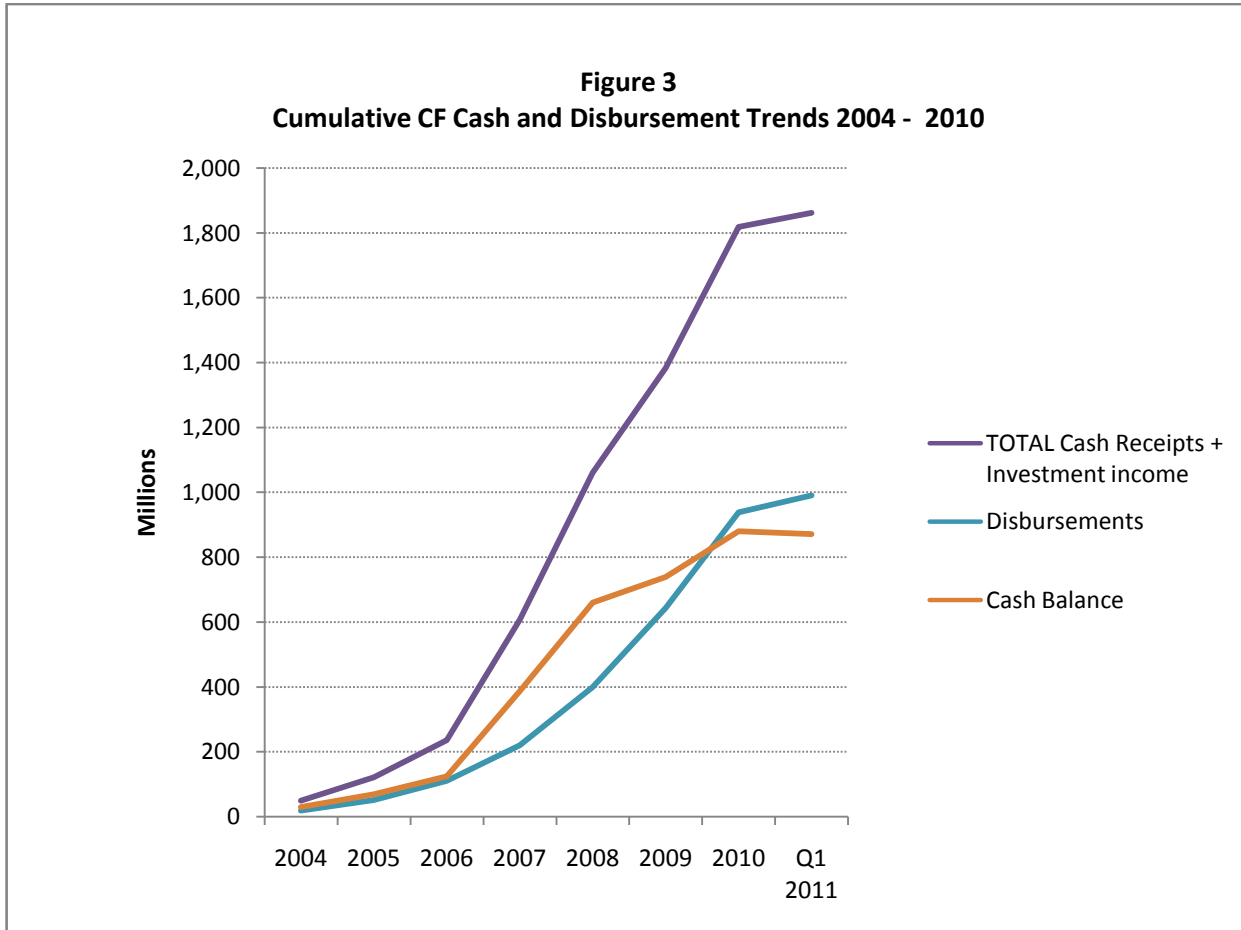
- **Cash Receipts:** Cash receipts in the first quarter of CY2011 totaled US\$40 million from the EU, Japan, Norway, Romania and Switzerland. Cumulative cash receipts since inception total US\$1,784.7 million.
- **Investment Income:** Income earned on undisbursed cash balances totaled US\$1.1 million in Q1 CY2011 with investment income since inception totaling US\$77 million. All investment income earned on cash balances is added back into the CF for allocation by the CF Committee<sup>1</sup>.
- **Disbursements:** CF grant disbursements in the quarter totaled US\$49.9 million. US\$981.8 million had been disbursed since CF inception (Figure 2 shows annual CF disbursements since fund inception. Table B shows all CF allocations since fund inception and actual disbursement for each as of March 31, 2011.

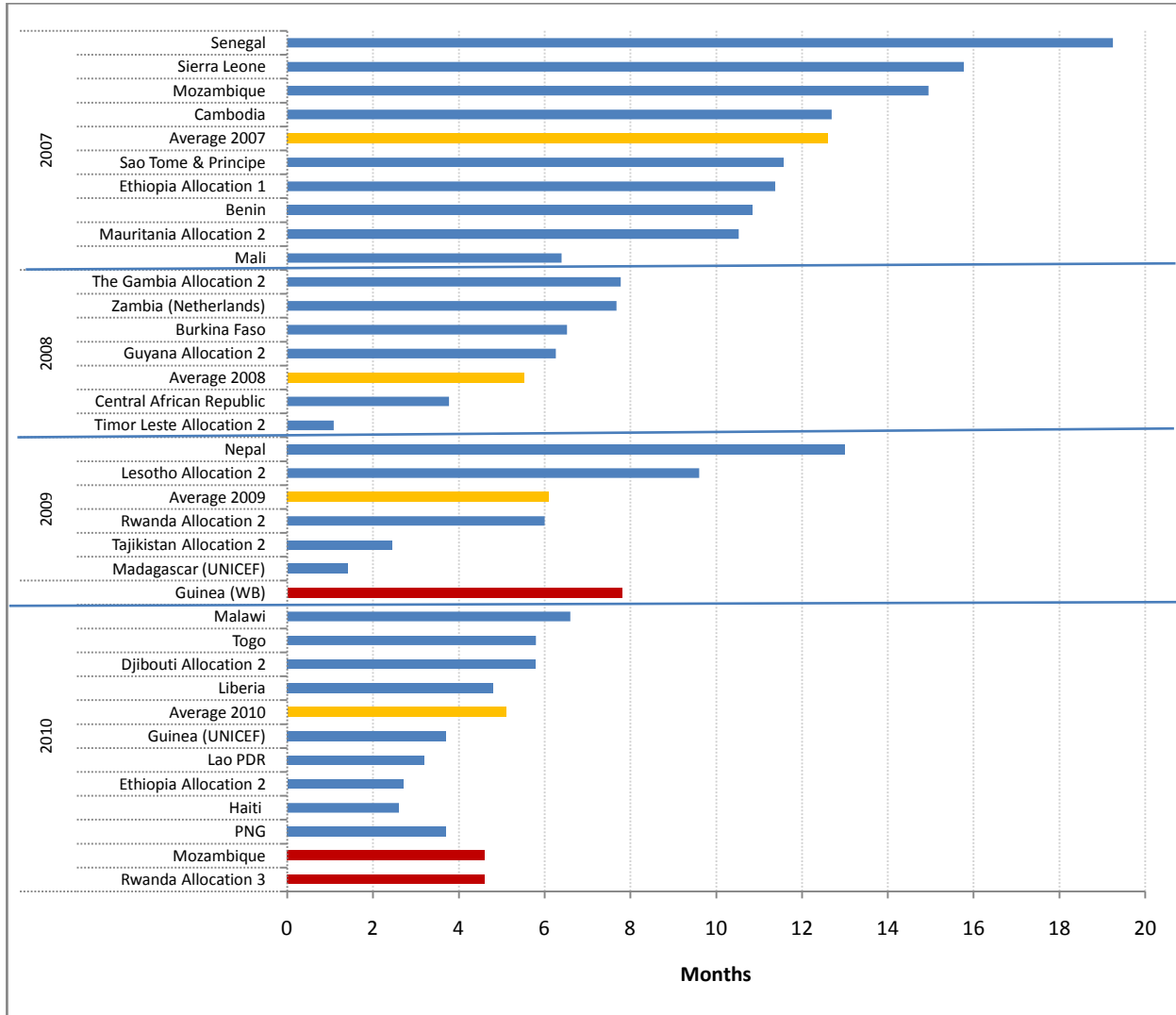
- **Cash Balance:** As of March 31, 2011, the cash balance of the CF was US\$871.8 million, down US\$9 million from 2010 Q4. Figure 3 below shows year-on-year trends for cumulative cash received (donor contribution receipts plus investment income), disbursements, and cash balance from CF inception.



## 2. GRANT PROCESSING

- **Signing of CF Grant Agreements:** One grant agreement was signed in the quarter – Papua New Guinea. As of March 31, grant agreements remained unsigned for the two CF allocations approved in November 2010 (Mozambique and Rwanda) and for the World Bank portion of the allocation made to Guinea. Figure 4 below highlights progress made since 2007 in reducing time between CF Committee allocation decision and signing of a grant or transfer agreement for the allocation. Grants unsigned at March 31, 2011 are shown in red.

### 3. FUNDS AVAILABLE AS OF MARCH 2011:

- The table summarizes the CF fund position as of March 31, 2011. The CF is almost fully committed with approximately US\$77.9 million left for allocation after taking into account the investment income. As mentioned previously, the signed pledges total includes approximately US\$248.8 million in funds pledged in non-US dollar currencies not yet received. This value is subject to exchange rate fluctuations that may result in a lesser amount being available.
