

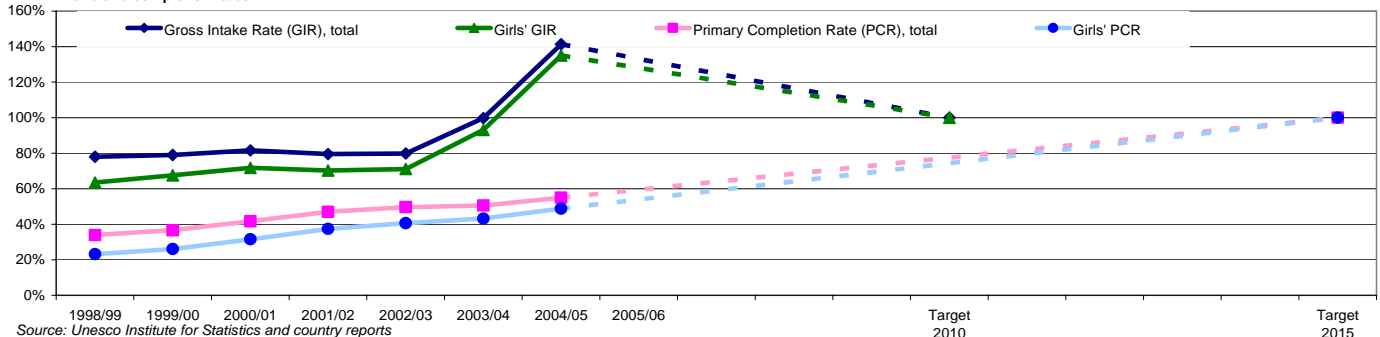

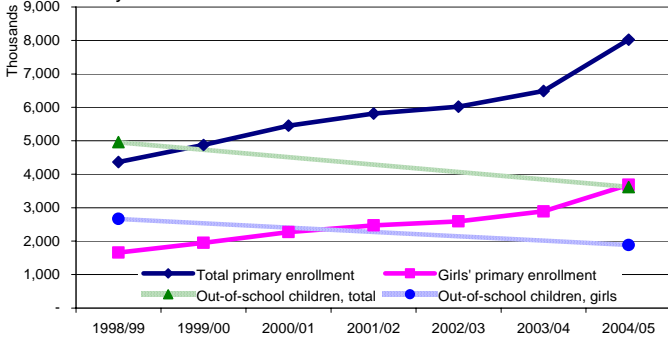

Intake and completion rates



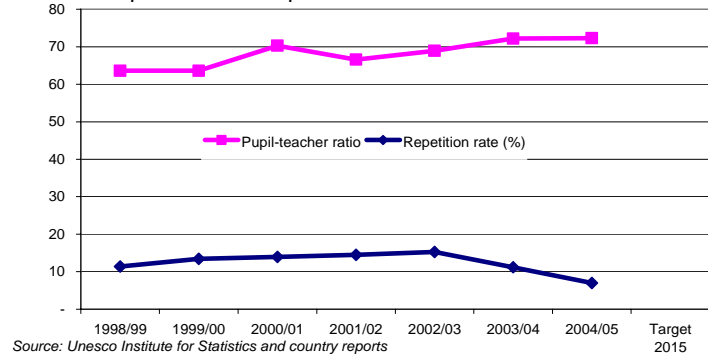

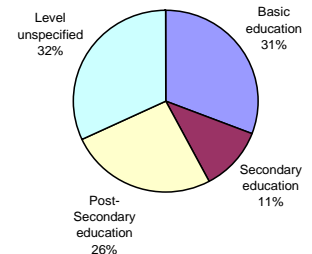
