I am writing to you regarding the Global Partnership for Education's 2015-2018 Replenishment Campaign Pledging Framework and the pledging conference to be held in Brussels on 25-26th June 2014.

Education and, more particularly vocational training, are key priorities of Luxembourg's Development Cooperation, both bilaterally and multilaterally. Luxembourg has been a member of and contributor to the GPE for many years, already when it was still the Fast Track Initiative. In 2014, we have contributed 300.000 euro to the GPE and we plan to remain at that level for 2015.
