Video Producer (STC)

Background

GPE is a shared commitment to ending the world's learning crisis. It is the only global partnership and fund dedicated entirely to helping children in lower-income countries get a quality education, so they can unlock their potential and contribute to building a better world.

GPE mobilizes partners and funds to help 76 partner countries transform their education systems and deliver quality learning to more girls and boys, especially those who are marginalized by poverty, gender, disability or displacement.

The GPE secretariat is hosted by the World Bank and has headquarters in Washington D.C and Paris, and an office in Brussels. In the Secretariat, the communications team is looking to hire a video producer and editor to support efforts to report on GPE's impact and results in partner countries.

This position is a short-term consultancy (STC) for initially 15 days between January 2021 and June 2021. More days can be added throughout the fiscal year if needed. The STC will report to Ludovica Pellicoli, External Affairs Officer, and work with others in the communication team. The position is remote, but the ideal candidate would be based in Europe.

Duties and Accountabilities:

The consultant will produce visual content for GPE's website and social media channels:

- Create engaging videos and animated shorts designed to be shared online and offline.
- Produce, shoot and edit video projects; re-purpose existing archival assets to create dynamic new products; produce content in multiple languages.
- Organize interviews, set-up, conduct and post-produce (subtitles, text animation and design) video pieces for corporate video projects.
- Provide all footage, b-roll, interviews (audio&video) and photos to the GPE Secretariat for future use

The work may require travel, when that is possible again.
